A brief listing of awards to consider are:

### **Teacher Educator of the Year Award**


Our top award given to the faculty member best exemplifying the values of teacher education.

**Distinguished Research Award** given to an individual faculty member for outstanding empirical research.

**Exemplary Service/Partnership Award** recognizes the development of partnership programs that connect IHEs with basic education and community partners and recognizes activities that provide service to the field of education.

Outstanding Dissertation Award recognizes excellence in doctoral dissertation research that contributes to the field of educator preparation or professional teaching practice.

Of course we don't want to overlook our outstanding pre-service teachers! If you know of a deserving junior or senior teacher certification student, please consider nominating her/him/them for our **Executive Directors' Scholarship**. - This fall, PAC-TE seeks nominations for candidates interested in serving on the Board of Directors.
- Some desired qualifications include familiarity with PAC-TE's mission & events, plus educator certification in Pennsylvania.
- Please email John Ward, PAC-TE Past President and Chair of the Nominations Committee, at john.ward@live.kutztown.edu with any questions about the positions on the ballot. Nominations and candidate information/photos must be received by September 30, 2024.

The terms for all four seats are three years and run from June 1, 2025, through May 31, 2028.

- One seat for a representative of a **Private** institution of higher education in Pennsylvania engaged in educator preparation. The current seat holder, Veronica Ent, is eligible for re-election.
- One seat for a representative of a **Public** institution of higher education in Pennsylvania engaged in educator preparation. Our association bylaws stipulate that at least one of three public seats must be held by a representative from a PASSHE institution, and a representative from a state-related institution (Pitt, Penn State, Temple, or Lincoln) must hold one. Since there is currently one Director from a PASSHE institution and one Director from a state-related institution, the nominee can be from either type of public institution. Current Director Danielle Bowers is up for re-election.
- <u>Two</u> seats for **At-Large** representatives. Candidates may come from any institution of higher education in Pennsylvania engaged in educator preparation. <u>Current Director</u> <u>Rachael Stevens is up for re-election. Current Director Stephanie Gardner is not eligible</u> for re-election as she is in the final year of her two-term limit and must sit out for at least one year before being re-elected to the Board.
- A special election for a **Treasurer**. This is a 3-year appointment and requires knowledge of bookkeeping, online banking, budgeting, and non-profit entities. The Treasurer receives a small stipend. Note: The Treasurer will begin serving immediately after the election results are known.
